Visit to Sudeley Castle with lunch at

the Wesley Rooms, Winchcombe

Tuesday 9th April 2019



Located in Winchcombe in the heart of the Cotswolds, Sudeley Castle & Gardens has played an important role in England's history for over 1,000 years. The castle rooms and exhibits contain many fascinating treasures, from ancient Roman times to the present day. The centrepiece is the Queens Garden, so named because four of England's queens – Anne Boleyn, Katherine Parr, Lady Jane Grey and Elizabeth I – once walked upon the original Tudor Parterre. Sudeley Castle & Gardens is also the only private castle in England to have a queen buried within its grounds – Katherine Parr, the last of Henry VIII's six wives. Today visitors can explore the beautiful 15th century church where she lies entombed. It is estimated that we will be at the castle around 2.00pm.

Entrance is the castle costs £12.50 and the talk costs £5. **Lunch:** We will stop for lunch at 12.00 noon in the Wesley House in Winchcombe which provides an excellent lunch for approximately £20. Wesley House is a 15th century Merchant's House whose restaurant has been awarded a AA * rosette and has developed a reputation for elegant surroundings, exemplary service and delivering great food using local suppliers and organic produce wherever possible. The April menu will be available to us to choose from before we travel. The **total cost is £50** per person.

Travel: We have booked a 33 seater coach from JR Coaches of Taffs Well and will use our usual pick up points of Lisvane Memorial Hall at 9.15am and Westminster Crescent / Cyncoed Road at 9.30am with a stop for coffee at the Gloucester Farm Shop Services on the M5. We will probably leave around 4.00pm and be home by 6.00pm.
